There is widespread disillusionment with the EU and membership has not brought the immediate prosperity which many imagined it would do. Poverty, especially in some remote areas, is a huge problem and our friends, Christina and Jacob are very much involved in helping to bring practical aid to the most impoverished. Their annual visit from Scottish doctors, nurses and other healthcare professionals was greatly appreciated. The Bible School, also known as Golgotha Mission, continues to be a major help to many Christians who attend short courses and conferences. Willie MacLean and Alastair Noble will be travelling out to Romania in May 2019 to preach at a conference for Christians who will travel from across the region. Please continue to pray for our friends in Romania.
