Read the Word on Sunday evenings - Again this month we will be coming together to read God’s Word followed by a short prayer time. This will be via zoom and more information and link will be sent out soon.

Our offering this month is for the work of **Foundation Totai** - This is an extract from an update that was sent to our Missionary Group and covers the first quarter to March 2020 when Totai temporarily shut down due to Co-vid 19.

The Health centre continued to provide essential healthcare at an affordable cost, especially ENT. New equipment allows the patient to see a screen showing what's in their ear during an examination and provides a better diagnosis. The Health centre recruited a paediatrician and a speech and language therapist. This supports the demand, especially to patients who need help with language delays and difficulties.

The children's football programme was attended by an average of 40 children. Weekly Bible studies took place.

A discipleship class for 5 teenagers took place using "The Purpose Driven Life".

Pray for safety and health of the Trinidad Community in Bolivia. Ask God to give the Bolivian government wisdom to protect the population's health. Pray for the financial stability of Totai, given the lack of income from health appointments.

Unfortunately this year we cannot collect donations in our usual manner on Harvest Sunday. The foodbank are partnering with Bankuet, who are using the money donated to supply with food stuffs.

We, along with Calderwood Baptist Church, are one of the first 25 churches to sign up so. If we raise £500, a further £250 will be added to our total.
