This month's offering is for **PopUK.** Here is an update from Andy Silver: I greatly value the ongoing, faithful support Westwoodhill show towards PopUK. The whole team and Trustees value it enormously.

Since the pandemic, PopUK has made significant changes to the way we work. We are no longer able to deliver school-based projects in person. This has been both challenging and exciting!

Pre Co-vid Work: From September 2019 - March 2020 we delivered projects in 32 schools. Each project enabled schools to strengthen their relationship with churches, parents and community groups. We also presented the project at Derby, Coventry, Nottingham Diocesan Head Teachers Conference. Another 20 projects booked between March - July but Co-vid put an immediate stop to any 'in-school' projects.

Work achieved during Covid:

- **1.** Launching Virtual Workshops Development of SMSC (Social; Moral; Spiritual; Cultural) learning, Christmas and Easter virtual online Workshops. 18 schools took up our Christmas workshops.
- **2. Creating 'Ready to go' Video Lessons:** 10 videos have been created and based on a variety of SMSC development topics.
- **3. Developing an Annual Membership Scheme:** Schools can now sign up to access our full library of songs and video lessons. We are currently marketing this offer to schools nationally in two phases:

Phase 1: (Jan - Feb) Internet Safety day Phase 2: (Mar - Apr) Easter projects.

We are immensely grateful for all the support we have received over the past year from Trust Funds and individuals, particularly through the Co-vid crisis.

Prayer requests:

- 165 schools have downloaded our free resources this week. These Resources will be sent to parents for their children to engage with at home. Pray that God will uses these to bring hope and assurance of God's love for each of them at this time.
- •Although the above is encouraging, we do have to create an income source. Pray that schools will be drawn towards paying our Annual Membership Scheme.
- •Please pray that we might be successful with our funding applications we have submitted this week.
