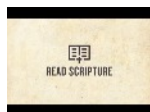

This month's offering and missionary focus is for **Derek & Amanda Paterson** serving the Lord with Operation Mobilisation. Below is an extract from their recent newsletter. The fuller newsletter will be sent out to the Church.

Over the past year, Logos Hope has been through a very complicated time, however the "mission remains the mission" and we have been able to be involved in assisting some vulnerable communities in the Caribbean. This included bringing Help and Hope to the Abaco Islands which were devastated by hurricane Dorian over a year ago. Right now, Logos Hope is in Curaçao and about to go into dry-dock (annual maintenance programme). The ship crew and community remain incredibly positive even through such challenges and constant change and we continue to invest in training and planning in readiness for the next opportunity.

Derek has been working from home with no travelling for the first time in our married life, leading to a feeling of cabin fever from time to time. He has held meetings with those serving with OM throughout the world, with the team on Logos Hope and with many of OM partners and donors.

Amanda has been able to combine counselling sessions within schools and online for children and young people throughout Shropshire & Cheshire. Emotional well-being has been a challenge for young and old alike as we have been navigating COVID restrictions. Our home also became a Foodbank for a few months as we coordinated food packages being delivered to local vulnerable families.

Matthew has started a new job and took on and completed cycling challenge of 3500 km! Rachel plans to study a Masters degree once graduating from her current degree.
