This month's offering and missionary focus is on **South East Asia Bible School in Myanmar**

We have not heard directly from the Bible school in Myanmar but Kap Thang, one of the leaders at the school, wrote to Ian Burness who has shared this information for our prayers.

The 3rd wave of covid has kept the Bible school closed and nearly all other schools also. The political situation is getting worse. We need your continued prayers for the Lord's protection, justice, freedom. peace and provision. Please pray for the safety of the displaced people.

Many of us will have seen pictures in the news of the tensions Within the country. It must be very difficult to live with the changing political and economic structure. This must be made worse with covid. They are very grateful to have the prayer support from other Christians at this time.

The financial gift that we send can be used in other ways while the Bible school is closed. Funds can be used for those in need both in the local community and also those in the wider area. Some will be from the Church and others are not, but this gives them the opportunity to share the gospel. It will be used for food, clothes and other essentials. They are so thankful to have our continued support.

We are thankful that we are now able to meet together in a less restricted way and that we can now sing (albeit with our masks still on). As restrictions continue to change, please check you emails for any more updates.
