Despite the restrictions in 2020, the JAM Club built the "Nativity" at town centre for the whole month of December. We also noted an increase use of the electronic "Advent Calendar" on the JAM website and we built an Easter Exhibition at the town centre in March 2021.

This month there will be a Nativity Scene again the town centre and from 1<sup>st</sup> of December we have arranged outreach teams to be at the site during 3 weekends. Please pray for a good response from the Community.

We are hoping to relocate the JAM shop to a more accessible unit to be used as a Youth Centre.

In January we are expecting the reopening of the Stewartfield Community Hall for our weekly Sunday Club. Please pray that children in the area will be interested to come along and hear of our Saviour.
