This month's missionary focus and offering is for the work of **Golgotha Mission (Bible School), Romania**

As with so many parts of the world, Romania has been affected significantly by the Covid pandemic. When compared to the UK, Romania is still a poor country and it's health service falls far short of what we have come to expect for our NHS. So far only about 30% of Romanians have received 2 doses of a Covid vaccination and their infection rate continues to rise.

Talmaciou and many of the villages in the area have a high percentage of very poor people. Jacob and Cristina are constantly working to bring help in situations of dire poverty where there is very little help available from the government. Poverty and significant health challenges remains a huge problem in spite of EU membership which many people believed would bring prosperity to Romania.

Willie MacLean has preached several times in Romania during lockdown but that's been by Zoom. However, the numbers attending services on zoom and in churches, such as Talmaciou, where the preaching is shown on a large screen are encouragingly high. However, It may be some time before a visit in person would be wise.

In spite of all their difficulties, Jacob and Cristina continue to lead a growing ministry in Talmaciou and the surrounding area. Golgotha Mission (Bible School) continues to be a thriving centre for training in Christian mission. Various conferences are arranged for church leaders, young people, men and women.

Just before lockdown a visitor from "the west" was able to produce a video which provides a useful insight to some aspects of their ministry. We hope to make this available to everyone during the next few weeks.

Please continue to pray for our friends in Romania.
