This month's offering is for Luwero Community Projects.

Uganda continues to be affected by tough Covid restrictions due to majority of the Ugandan population being unvaccinated, only around 11% of the Ugandan population have received 2 doses. This has impacted the running of the project with the schools being closed and within other aspects of the project. The church is now able to hold 200 people in their services, they are holding 3 services each Sunday, along with other mid-week Bible study groups. There is a possibility being explored for expansion, with more land for farming, we hope that this opportunity will come to fruition.

Please pray for the Covid-19 situation in Uganda and for their roll out of vaccinations to allow for the running of the projects to normalise.

Uganda continues to be a politically unstable country, with attacks and government chaos being common occurrences. Pray for stability for the Ugandan people and a political environment that allows Luwero CP to work and grow.

Back in early November, Gabriel attended a 3-day seminar with other pastors and leaders, which has brought a possibility for planting another church. Recently Deborah has been unwell due to diabetes and baby Debbie scalded herself with hot water, we pray for recovery for both of them. Please continue to keep Gabriel, Deborah and the Kijjambu children in your prayers.
